

# Catch-Up Premium Report (2016)



*Believe, Succeed, Together*

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## 1.0 Definition of Catch-Up Premium

The 'Catch-up Premium' is additional funding to support Year 7 pupils who did not achieve [the expected standard](#) (scaled score of 100) in Reading and/or Mathematics at the end of KS2.

## 2.0 Income and Expenditure

In 2015-16, there were **21** pupils eligible for the Catch-Up Premium (**11%** of the year group) for which the Academy received funding of **£10, 500**. A breakdown of the expenditure is detailed below.

TUT	Tuition	21	£5, 000	The Academy employed tutors on a part time basis in English and Mathematics. These tutors worked with Catch-Up Premium pupils on a 1:1 basis and/or in small groups. All Catch-Up Premium pupils received up to 15 hours tuition throughout the year and the level of provision was determined by the rate of progress towards the expected standard.
AS	Additional staff	21	£3, 000	The Academy allocated additional staff in key areas to allow the creation of smaller group teaching in English and Mathematics in Year 7, focusing on Catch-Up Premium pupils struggling to achieve the expected standard.
LSA	Learning Support	21	£2, 000	The Academy used funds to partly pay for the salary of one LSA who was employed specifically to work with Catch-Up Premium pupils inside the classroom and also in Homework Club which operates daily from 3.35 – 4.30 p.m.
ABS	Attendance Support	21	£500	The Academy used funds to partly pay for the cost of the LA Attendance Support Service to improve the attendance of Catch-Up Premium pupils.

## 3.0 Impact of Funding

Year Group	% Meeting or Exceeding Expected Standard (English)	% Meeting or Exceeding Expected Standard (Mathematics)
7	100%	83%

All pupils managed to meet or exceed the expected standard in English. Two pupils failed to meet the expected standard in Mathematics and support will continue in 2016-17 until the expected standard is met.

## **4.0 Catch-Up-Premium Strategy 2016-17**

### **4.1 Aim**

To ensure Catch-Up Premium funds are spent in a targeted way, ensuring that pupils receive additional support to reach the expected standard in English (Reading) and Mathematics.

### **4.2 Outcome**

To ensure 100% of pupils meet or exceed the expected standard in English (Reading) and Mathematics.

### **4.3 Funding**

Prior to 2016-17, schools received £500 per pupil for those eligible for the Catch-Up Premium.

In 2016-17 schools will receive the same overall amount of Year 7 Catch-Up Premium funding they received in 2015-16, adjusted to reflect the % change in the size of their Year 7 cohort, based on the October 2016 census.

In 2016-17, there were **58** pupils who did not meet the expected standard (**28%** of the year group) for which the Academy will receive funding of **£11, 172..**

### **4.4 Strategy**

Tuition and learning support will be provided to small cohorts during form time, 20 minutes a day, until the expected standard is met. The main resources that will be used are 'Catch up Maths' <http://catchupmaths.net/> and a bespoke English programme delivered by a primary trained specialist. Further, additional learning support will be assigned to pupils during normal timetabled curriculum time.

### **4.5 Review**

The strategy will be reviewed on a half-termly basis by the Assistant Principal, Mr. M. Cartlidge.
